As a Community Health Nurse, you will interact with the medical community to facilitate exams and treatment plans for clients. You will also prepare a variety of educational materials on various health topics, and present this information to clients. Because the success of families is important to the mission of AYS, you will co-facilitate Family Support Groups for program participants and their family members. Professional development is vital, and AYS will expect you to receive a minimum of 10 hours of training per year. Minor travel will be required as necessary to promote public relations with community agencies and for professional development activities.

Requirements / Qualifications

The ideal candidate will demonstrate a sincere interest in the welfare of program participants; a caring attitude; the ability to interact and cooperate with both clients and team members; the ability to respond to difficult situations with firmness, maturity, control, and empathy. Graduations from an approved school of nursing and successful completion of RN examinations are required. Previous nursing experience, preferably with adolescents, is strongly preferred.
