Duties:	Volunteers are asked to play basketball with the junior high and high school students of AYS Academy.
What is meaningful about this position?	AYS Academy is an alternative school for high school students who have been suspended form 3 to 6 months. Basketball is an activity our youth enjoy and benefit from. It is both a form of physical education and a positive form of recreation. A companion on the basketball court can also become a mentor for a young person.
Dates Needed:	Volunteers are needed on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:30- 2:00 during the regular school year. Individuals should make a 3 month commitment to a weekly volunteering schedule.

Age Requirement:	18+ (younger with an adult chaperone)
Desired Qualifications:	No experience is need. Basketball skills would be appreciated.
Training provided:	Volunteers will receive training on-site.
Length of commitment:	At least 3 months, 1-2 hours per week.
